The Inflation Reduction Act

Effective January 1st, 2023, per the Inflation Reduction Act, Care N' Care beneficiaries will pay no more than \$35 for a one-month supply of covered insulin products (no more than \$70 for a three-month supply).

Effective January 1st, 2023, Care N' Care beneficiaries will pay a \$0 copay for adult vaccines that are approved by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) <https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/adults/rec-vac/index.html>. This rule means that, in addition to receiving Medicare Part B-covered vaccines such as flu, pneumococcal and COVID-19 at zero cost, members will also receive vaccines that normally pay under Part D (such as Shingrix, Tdap and Hepatitis B) at zero cost. Part D covered vaccines must be billed to the Part D benefit at an [in-network pharmacy](#). Providers may continue to administer Part B vaccines: flu, pneumococcal and COVID-19. However, for all other adult vaccines that are approved by ACIP, please refer the patient to their pharmacy, to receive these for a \$0 copay.
